

VULCANUS IN JAPAN

WHAT IS IT?

The programme consists of industrial placements for EU students. It starts in September and ends in August of the following year in order to accommodate the academic year in EU Member States.

The whole programme takes place in Japan. The students follow:

1/ a seminar on "Japan";

2/ a 4-month intensive Japanese language course;

3/ an 8-month traineeship in a Japanese company.

VULCANUS IN JAPAN started in 1997.

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

Applicants must be:

1/ EU nationals:

2/ engineering or science students (°);

3/ at the time of application, applicants must be registered at an EU University on a postgraduate or an undergraduate course (at least at the 3rd year).

The European students are awarded a grant of 2.000.000 yen to cover the cost of travel to and from Japan and living expenses in Japan. There is no charge for the language course and seminar, and accommodation is provided free of charge during the language course and the company traineeship.

Applicants are selected on the basis of their academic record and the opinion of their tutors, their knowledge of written and spoken English, their motivation, their attitude to EU-Japan relations and their ability to adapt to a different culture.

When will I receive the grant? Is it enough to live in Japan? 15 The JPY ¥ 2,000,000 VIJ grant will be paid in several instalments. The first payment will be made in September. Subsequent payments will be made until the end of the internship. Please refer to the contract for the payment terms. Previous Vulcanus students have found the grant sufficient to live on (enjoying a student lifestyle). Should you wish to undertake expensive activities (trips etc.), you will need to pay for them yourself. Who will purchase my ticket for Japan? 16 0 You will have to buy your own return air ticket. Under Japanese immigration rules all Vulcanus trainees must enter Japan on the same day. By e-mail, we will instruct you which day this will be.
